
Why ChalleNGe?

ChalleNGe Goals



The ChalleNGe program truly transforms the lives of its graduates. Cadets live, work and collaborate in Platoon groups as they complete the 22-week Residential Phase.

The Residential Phase emphasizes our Eight Core

Components. (See 3rd panel) Kentucky incorporates a

Level (Rank) System that rewards Cadets with privileges

for demonstrating good behavior. Academic training is provided by dedicated Teachers and includes self-paced,



computer-assisted efforts as part of the High School
Credit Recovery Program. The Cadre, who serve as strict
yet supportive Mentors, reinforce program goals and set
positive examples for Cadets to follow. Together, the
Cadre and Teachers form a united team, helping to
inspire individual growth and offering steady guidance
throughout the journey.

Graduates benefit from the ongoing support of Mentors and Academy Placement Coordinators during the 24 months following graduation. This includes assistance with further education, job opportunities, and career development.

Field Trips Add to Experience.

The Academy offers an array of enriching field trips each

cycle. Cadets visit

Frankfort to explore the State Capitol and gain a deeper understanding of government functions.



They visit many parks as part of Earth Sciences discussions and travel to various locations across the state to develop employability skills and learn about higher education and technical schools. Cadets also participate in trips to a bowling alley, a skating rink and Kentucky Kingdom. These experiences contribute to their life planning goals and reward positive behaviors.
